## VI.

### Justice Votes on the Same Side as the ACLU (Highest to Lowest Percentage)

The following chart shows how the 51 individual Justices voted in total vis-a-vis the ACLU's side. The chart shows, for example, that first on the list, Justice Cardozo, voted 100% on the side the ACLU was on. However, as shown in column B., he only voted on four ACLU cases.

Justice No. 6., Thurgood Marshall, voted on 431 of the ACLU Supreme Court cases, and he voted 85.85% for the same side as the ACLU. While Justice Cardozo won the highest percentage of voting for the side the ACLU was on, Justices Taft and Sanford (Numbers 50 and 51) never voted for the side the ACLU was on. Looking again at column B., the two Justices each voted on only two ACLU / Supreme Court cases.
