The Number and Percentage of Votes on the ACLU's Side by the Justices Nominated by Each President

This chart shows the voting in total of the Justices put on by each president and the ACLU cases each president's group voted on. The chart shows, for example, that Lyndon B. Johnson nominated two Justices, and those two justices voted on 467 ACLU cases, voting on the side the ACLU was on 399 times. Therefore, Johnson's Justices voted on the side of the ACLU 85.44%, the highest percentage of votes on the ACLU's side.

On the flip side, Donald Trump put two Justices on the Court. They voted 50 times on ACLU cases, voting with the side the ACLU 15 times, or 30.00% of the time.

Franklin D. Roosevelt put eight Justices on the Court (he served four terms as president), and they voted on 772 ACLU cases, voting on the ACLU's side 549 times, or 71.11% of the time. Roosevelt's Justices had the most votes for the side the ACLU was on of any other president.
