1920 – 1950

Roger Nash Baldwin, Co-founder of the ACLU, was the first ACLU Executive Director, and he served in that capacity for 30 years. His books include *Liberty Under the Soviets*, 1928, and *Juvenile Courts and Probation*, in 1914 as Co-writer. He received a master's degree in social work from Harvard.

1950 – 1962

Patrick Murphy Malin was the second ACLU Executive Director and served for 12 years after Roger Baldwin. Malin was an economics professor at Swarthmore College from 1930 to 1950.

1962 – 1970

Jack Pemberton served as ACLU Executive Director through most of the '60s. He graduated from Harvard Law School, became a law professor, and was regional counsel of the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission in San Francisco.
