The ACLU's Wins and Losses at the U.S. Supreme Court (Alphabetically)

The following chart lists alphabetically the 1,193 ACLU / U.S. Supreme Court cases. The chart also indicates where each case (with a short analysis) can be found in the companion 3-volume set. For example, in Column F., Case No. 3. *Adams v. Williams* is case No. 227 in Volume 1 of the 3-volume set.

During the years of putting this data together, I was asked on numerous occasions how many times the ACLU was a party in their Supreme Court cases. Column B. shows that the ACLU was a party in only six of its 1,193 cases.

The chart also shows that the ACLU filed amicus briefs in 969 or 83.61% of the 1,193 cases, and shows which cases were considered ACLU wins or losses.

N.B. Column C., Attorney of Record/ACLU Attorney, is not complete and it would take years to complete if it ever could be completed. Completing that column would at least entail tracking each lawyer listed on each Supreme Court brief, and those attorneys contributing to those briefs, and researching which of those attorneys met this project's criteria to be counted as an ACLU attorney. Therefore, column C. is not totaled, as I believe showing an incomplete total would be meaningless if not misleading.
