Justice Votes on the Same Side as the ACLU (Highest to Lowest Percentage)

The chart below shows how the 51 Supreme Court Justices voted individually vis-a-vis the ACLU's side. For example, Justice Arthur Joseph Goldberg, first on the list, voted **97.14%** on the side the ACLU supported. Column B. shows that he voted on 35 ACLU Supreme Court cases. Column F. shows he was nominated for the Court by Democratic President John F. Kennedy.

Justice No. 6., Thurgood Marshall, voted on **532** of the ACLU Supreme Court cases, and voted **81.20%** on the same side as the ACLU.

Justices William Howard Taft and Edward Terry Sanford (**Numbers 50 and 51**) never voted for the side the ACLU was on, but each only voted on two ACLU Supreme Court cases.
