## The Number and Percentage of Votes on the ACLU's Side by the Justice(s) Nominated by Each President

This chart shows which President put which Justices on the Court, how many ACLU cases each “President’s Justice(s)” voted on,<sup>13</sup> and the percentages of cases in which each President’s Justice(s) sided with the ACLU.

For example, the chart shows that Lyndon B. Johnson put two Justices on the Court, and those two Justices voted on **580 ACLU** cases, voting on the ACLU’s side **472** times. Therefore, Johnson’s Justices voted on the side of the ACLU **81.38%**, the highest percentage of Presidential Justice votes on the ACLU’s side.

The last president, Donald Trump, put two Justices on the Court. They voted **51** times on ACLU cases, voting with the side of the ACLU **11** times, or **21.57%** of the time, the lowest percentage of votes on the ACLU’s side.
