The ACLU's Wins and Losses at SCOTUS (Alphabetically by Case Title)

The following chart lists the 1,193 decided ACLU / SCOTUS cases alphabetically, showing where each case can be found in this Handbook's companion three-volume set. For example, on page 26, in Columns G / H, the case summary for *Abrams v. Johnson*, case number 2, is found in Vol. 2 as case number 828.

During the years of putting this data together, I was asked, on numerous occasions, how many times was the ACLU a party in its Supreme Court cases. Column D, also on page 26, shows that the ACLU was a party in seven of the 1,193 cases. The x's in that column show which cases they are.

In addition to Columns E / F showing which cases were considered ACLU wins or losses, the following chart also shows that of the 1,193 ACLU / US Supreme Court cases:

- **976** cases or **81.81%** of the 1,193 cases were Amicus filings
- **210** cases, or **17.6%**, were as "Attorney of Record / ACLU Attorney" (see footnote number 10 on page 26)
- **Seven** cases or **.59%** were when the ACLU was A Party in a case

N.B. Column C, Attorney of Record/ACLU Attorney, is probably not complete and it would take years to complete if it ever could be accurately compiled. Completing that column would entail at least tracking each lawyer listed on each Supreme Court brief and those attorneys contributing to those briefs as well as researching which of those attorneys met this work's criteria to be counted as an ACLU attorney.

If there are cases that have the exact same name, then they will be listed by earliest date first. The year the case was decided will be in parentheses only for the cases with the same name; a full date will be added if they also share the same year and put in order from earliest to most recent date.

¹⁰ There are 228 cases shown with x's for "Attorney of Record / ACLU Attorney." Eighteen of those cases were with the "Amicus" or with "As a Party" cases. So as not to double count, the eighteen were grayed out in Column C for ease of viewing.
